

Taking Gathered Worship Home

Please use the devotional material below each day this week to praise Christ. Ask Jesus to teach us His ways that we may walk in them to accomplish His purposes.

Sunday Morning

READ **Philippians 4:2-3; Matthew 5:21-26; Philippians 2:1-5; Romans 15:1-7; Second Corinthians 13:11-14; Psalm 133:1-3.** DISCUSS What does our animosity towards fellow Christians say about Jesus? How can we experience the unity Christ has won for us? What changes are needed as a result of these truths? MEDITATE on **Romans 12:16.** PRAY “Jesus, enable us to rejoice in You together.”

Sunday Evening

Monday

READ **Philippians 4:2-3; Philippians 2:1-5; Psalm 133:1-3.** DISCUSS What does it mean to be of the same mind? How is this related to dwelling together in unity? SERVE by putting someone else's interests *above your own!* MEDITATE on **Romans 12:16.** PRAY, “Lord, *make us know Your love* with certainty. Teach us to keep short accounts with one another and to be generous with forgiveness as You are with us.”

Tuesday

READ **Philippians 4:2-3; Matthew 5:21-26; Psalm 22:1-31.** DISCUSS How important is reconciliation to Jesus? What is the role of brothers in this psalm? How do our relationships together affect our praise of Christ? MEDITATE on **Romans 12:16.** PRAY, “Jesus, we are often petty and easily offended. Teach us to love like You love. Enable us to love one another in the mundane realities of everyday life.”

Wednesday

READ **Philippians 4:2-3; Romans 15:1-7; Psalm 122:1-9**. DISCUSS How do harmony and being in accord with Christ work together? What does it mean practically to promote peace with our brothers/sisters? MEDITATE on **Romans 12:16**. PRAY, “Lord, forgive us for our cold hearts towards one another. We know *we are powerless to love others as we should*, but help us to make use of the tools You have given us to nurture the warmth You provide.”

Thursday

READ **Philippians 4:2-3; Second Corinthians 13:11-14; Psalm 133:1-3**. DISCUSS What does it mean to aim for restoration? How are we actively cultivating peace with one another? Ask the Lord to meet you in your weakness. MEDITATE on **Romans 12:16**. PRAY, “Lord, please be strong in our weakness. Embolden our feeble hearts, we beg You.”

Friday

READ **Philippians 4:2-3; Matthew 5:21-26; Philippians 2:1-5; Romans 15:1-7; Second Corinthians 13:11-14; Psalm 133:1-3**. DISCUSS, What have you been learning from these passages? How has God been convicting you from these passages this week? MEDITATE on **Romans 12:16**. PRAY that we at FCCW would *honor Christ*.

Saturday

PREPARE today for the service tomorrow which is *available both in-person and via live-stream*. READ **Philippians 4:1-23**. Invite others to join you tomorrow for *Sunday School at 9:00* and the *10:30 service*. Ask Jesus to gather us together joyfully to praise Him.
